Public Statement

An employee of St John Ambulance Australia SA Inc has recently been arrested and charged by SAPOL in relation to the alleged misappropriation of private information, including the credit card details of some of our customers. The employee was immediately removed from the workplace.

We are naturally deeply concerned about this matter and wish to assure our customers and the community that customer privacy is of the utmost importance to us. We are taking all necessary steps to ensure that an incident of the nature alleged is not repeated.

We have contacted customers who are potentially affected by the alleged offending during the time frame of October 2017 to May 2018.

While this matter is before the court, and while SAPOL conducts its investigation, we are not able to provide any further information. We are assisting SAPOL with their investigation.

We value enormously our customers' support as this allows us to sustain and grow our vital community work.
