Overview

Course Duration

Online pre-learning and assessment will take up to 4 hours to complete. It is mandatory for participants to complete the online theory assessment prior to undertaking virtual classroom, this can be done at a time that is suitable to the participant. The virtual classroom, including practical assessments, will take 4 hours to complete.
