Overview

It provides the skills and knowledge required to recognise and respond quickly in an anaphylaxis or asthma emergency, as well as looking at how to use asthma and anaphylaxis action plans, how to effectively use prescribed medications for these conditions and how to conduct an anaphylaxis/asthma risk assessment for the workplace/education setting.

- First aid response to asthmatic emergencies, allergic reactions and anaphylaxis
