

# Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR)



HLTAID009 Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation



## Overview

The St John Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) course gives you the skills to perform CPR on a person who is unconscious and not breathing normally in line with the Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) guidelines. You will require the knowledge and confidence to perform CPR on an adult, child and infant, to describe alternative methods for delivering rescue breaths.

## Course Duration

St John offers the following options:

- 2.5 hours face-to-face workshop: using immersive technology (requires participant to have mobile phone (i.e. smartphone) to participate.

## Certificate

On successful completion of this course you will be issued a statement of attainment in:

- HLTAID009 Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation

St John recommends, as per the First Aid in the Workplace Code of Practice and the Australian Resuscitation Council guidelines, that first aid skills are renewed every 3 years and resuscitation skills (HLTAID009/HLTAID015) are renewed every 12 months.

## Course Outline

The course covers the following:

- DRSABCD action plan and responding to emergency situations
- Managing unconscious breathing casualties
- Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR)
- Using a defibrillator (AED)
- Legal issues in first aid
- Infection control

## Assessment Methods

A successful outcome for this statement of attainment will be determined by a range of different methods including written assessment, observation of simulated and practical activities, etc.

You will be required to demonstrate CPR on a manikin on the floor.
