Overview

This St John Ambulance first aid course covers a comprehensive range of topics to enable participants to confidently manage emergency situations and provide a first aid response to a casualty. It covers the most common injuries and illnesses.

It is suitable for both people in the workplace and members of the public who want training in first aid.

Course Duration

St John offers the following options:

- Half-day (face-to-face and online: 4.75 hours)
 - Offered in a blended format
 - Participants first complete the knowledge component of the course via online pre-learning and assessment. The duration of this is dependent on the participant's existing level of current first aid knowledge. This must be completed prior to attending the face-to-face workshop.
 - The face-to-face workshop covers all the practical requirements of the course, including assessment.
- 1-day (face-to-face workshops):
 - 1-day face-to-face course using immersive technology (requires participant to have mobile phone (i.e. smartphone) to participate).
 - The 1 day course duration is 8.5 hours (breaks included).
 - There is no requirement to complete pre-work prior to attending.
- 100% Online (virtual):
 - Covers the same comprehensive range of topics as a face-to-face first aid course, however participants can learn all this without having to leave their home or workplace.
 - Participants are required to complete online pre-learning and assessment, prior to attending the virtual practical workshop with assessment. The duration of this is dependent on the participant's existing level of current first aid knowledge.
 - The virtual classroom session takes 5 hours and is in real time, live with a Trainer on a video conference with a small group of students.
 - For the virtual classroom, participants will need multiple devices (i.e. smart phone and tablet or laptop) and internet access to be able to attend. Participants will also need a second person available during the practical assessments to enable them to demonstrate providing first aid to another person.
- 2 days face-to-face workshop: This is a full face-to-face course and participants are required to attend both the days.
 - Covers the same comprehensive range of topics as the face-to-face course, however it does not use immersive technology and there is no pre-work.
 - Participants must attend both days
 - This course is recommended for participants who do not feel comfortable with technology and/or want a slower-paced learning experience.
- Assessment only (face-to-face):
 - This course is for those who are confident in their skills and only want to complete the assessment.

On successful completion of this course you will be issued a statement of attainment in:

- HLTAID010 Provide basic emergency life support
- HLTAID011 Provide First Aid

St John recommends, as per the First Aid in the Workplace Code of Practice and the Australian Resuscitation Council guidelines, that first aid skills are renewed every 3 years and resuscitation skills (HLTAID009/HLTAID015) are renewed every 12 months.

- Stroke

Assessment Methods

A successful outcome for this course will be determined by a range of different methods including written assessment and observation of simulated practical activities.

You will be required to demonstrate CPR on an adult manikin on the floor.
